CAUTION: Before connecting the fixture to power supply, be sure that the power is switched off.



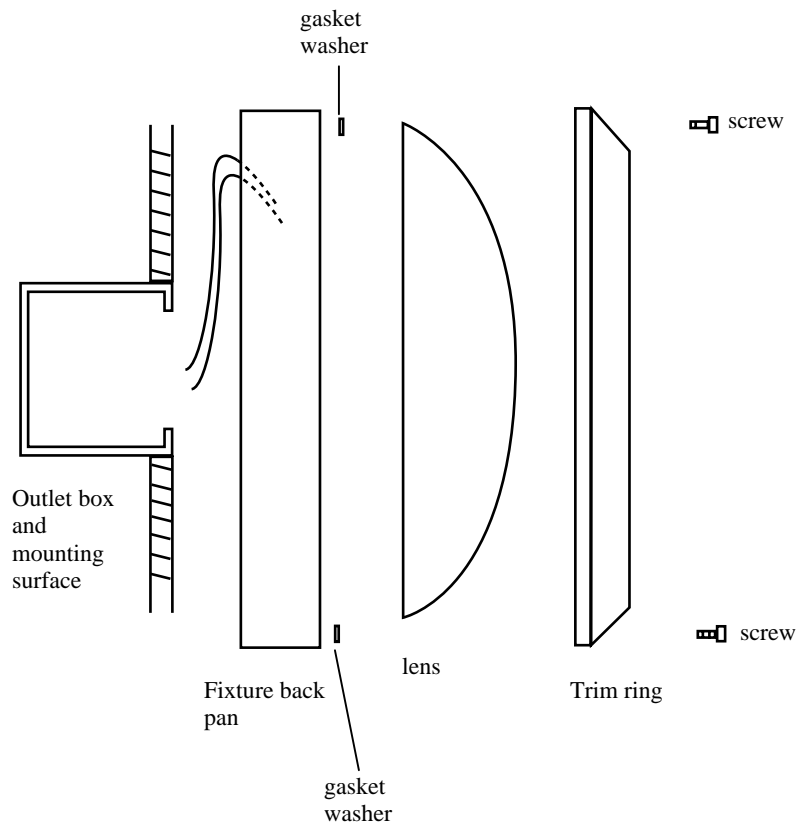

Instructions:

1. Fixture comes complete and must first be disassembled to install. Start by removing the lens and trim ring by removing four screws, being certain not to lose the gasket washers on the screws which are between the fixture body and trim ring. Set items aside.
2. Once disassembled to this point, make power supply connections to fixture.
3. Mount the fixture directly to the electrical supply box (j-box) using holes provided. **Note:** The outer edge of the fixture that comes in contact with the mounting surface must be silicone caulked by the installer. This is critical for a safe and reliable installation. Power supply wires will lie between the fixture and mounting surface.
4. Replace reflector and lamp per label requirements. (Lamps are provided by others)
5. Replace lens and trim ring using screws and washers set aside in step one, being certain that gasket washers are installed between the trim ring and fixture housing.

GENERAL

1. Before starting the installation, disconnect the power by turning of the circuit breaker or by removing the fuse at the fuse box. Turning the power off at the light switch is not sufficient to prevent electrical shock.
 2. To ensure the success of the installation, be sure to read these instructions and review the diagrams thoroughly before beginning.
 3. All electrical connections must be in accordance with local codes, ordinances, or the national electrical code.
 4. These fixtures are intended to be mounted to a 4" x 2-1/8" deep metal octagon outlet box. The box must be directly supported by the building structure.
- Note:** The important safeguards and instructions appearing in this manual are not meant to cover all possible conditions and situations that may occur.
